


HISTORY OF THE DRUG:AZT

Who discovered the drug?

In 1983 researchers at the Institute Pasteur in Paris indentified the retroviruses now known as (HIV)as the cause of (AIDS)

When was the drug first introduced?

The drug was first introduced on March 19,1987 when it was approved by the FDA. It was approved in record time with only one trial

When did it become a therapeutic medicine?

The first AIDS drug was approved on March 19,1987. The therapy is not really clear but it was approved around the 80s and 90s

What causes the disease in the body?
